HOTV Board Meeting May 7, 2014 Notes by Karen Hans

The meeting was called to order by Armand Schoppy at 7:15 PM

501 3 c vs 501 c 4

An IRS agent reviewed our application and determined HOTV is more of an 501 c 4 organization rather than 501 3 c

501 c 4 is non profit but contributions are not tax deductible

In order to qualify for 501 c 3, 95% of activities must be associated with club activities.

Options:

Withdraw application Reapply with new language, will cost \$1200 Accept 501 c 4 status

What is the benefit to the club of 501 3 c status?

Past tax deductible donation are okay to companies that has previously donated

Since we never operated as an 501 3 c, we don't need to dissolve bank accounts.

Patrick thinks best thing to do is accept 501 c 4 status

A 501 c 4 status is easier for HOTV to manage

It will be a stretch to re-file as 501 3 c, BUT we may want to file for 501 3 c status for Septembeer Fest

There are no tax differences between 501 3 c vs 501 c 4 except to donors. However,

501 3 c will restrict club's ability to fund club events like picnic and Christmas party.

IRS needs response by May 15; Patrick needs to send letter to IRS May 8;

Patrick motions HOTV accept IRS designation as 501 c 4 designation;

Carrie seconds;

Board votes yes anonymously;

Septembeer Fest:

Patrick is working on budget; expects cost to be higher;

Will be a Benton Co Expo Center; will cost more to rent facilities

Coordinate volunteers with Corvallis Beer Week for servers;

Insurance is covered under Oregon Beverage;

Security with big burly guys;

Still need to finalize pricing... keep at \$15 with 4 tokens and raise additional tokens to \$1.25, for \$5...or \$20 for 8 tokens;

Liberty Mutual Insurance called Patrick about the HOTV coverage;

Coverage dropped from \$1200 to \$500 because of restriction on minors; no minors after 6 PM; no one between 10 and 21;

Start charging \$3 for designation driver.

Board needs to draft an Electronic Media policy for Facebook posts;

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 PM;

The 27th edition of the OBF will take place during Oregon Craft Beer Month along Portland's waterfront from July 23rd through 27th.

The 2014 Oregon Brewers Festival will feature 88 handcrafted beers from 85 breweries across North America, including two gluten-free offerings. And this year the festival will be offering another 40+ beers pouring in the Specialty Tent during the event. There are few new brewery's attending OBF for the very first time, including one from Canada.

Times Weds through Sat, taps are open from Noon to 9 pm Sun, taps are open from Noon to 7 pm Token & glass sales close one-half hour prior to the taps shutting off: this is 8:30pm every night except 6:30pm on Sunday.

Admission into the festival grounds is free. In order to consume beer, purchase of a 2014 souvenir tasting glass is required and costs \$7. No other vessel will be filled. Beer is purchased with wooden tokens, which cost \$1 apiece. Patrons pay four tokens for a full glass of beer, or one token for a taste.
